## INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE MINOR SURGERY (LOCAL ANESTHETIC)

- Please read and follow all directions carefully. Failure to do so could result in cancellation of your surgery.
- Do not use Aspirin, Vitamin E capsules, Garlic supplements, or anti-inflammatories (Advil, Motrin, Naprosyn, Celebrex etc) for 2 weeks prior to your surgery unless cleared with your surgeon.
- If you are taking **Coumadin/Warfarin/Heparin/Plavix or another blood thinner** please check with your surgeon whether you will need to stop prior to surgery. If you need to stop it you may require bloodwork (INR/PTT) drawn at the hospital the morning of or night before your surgery.
- No alcoholic beverages 24 hours prior to surgery.
- Please have someone at the hospital to drive you home upon discharge.
- Please advise us of any changes in your health or medications since your last visit.
- Remove all jewellery from hands and wrists prior to surgery.
- Please advise us if you have been, or are, required to take antibiotics for surgical procedures or dental work, due to a heart condition.

Please note your surgery may be postponed should an urgent surgical case take priority. Do not hesitate to contact the office if you have any questions.

Report to Minor Procedures 1 hour prior to surgery. Minor Procedures clinic is located on the main floor – Health Sciences North (turn LEFT – past Tim Horton's and then right).
